### Travel to Szczecin

#### From Świnoujście Port to Szczecin

##### By train

Here you will find the route planner for trains in Poland

You should type in the windows: From: Świnoujście Centrum; To: Szczecin Główny

**Price: 16-25 PLN**

**Important information:** you should remember that on the Świnoujście train station you can pay only by cash!

#### From Szczecin-Goleniów Airport to Szczecin

##### By train:

The airport is 7 km from the railway station in Goleniów. Trains to Szczecin run approximately every hour or even more frequently.

You should type in the windows: From: Goleniów; To: Szczecin Główny Taxi fare from the airport to Goleniów train station. **Price: 25 PLN**

Train fare from Goleniów to Szczecin. **Price: 20 PLN**

##### By Taxi:

From the airport to the city centre, use Airport Taxi Group (phone +48 91 481-76-90).

**Price: 100–150 PLN**

##### By Bus:

Ryanair and Norwegian Air passengers can use buses from the Interglobus company, whose travel times are coordinated with the flight schedules. You can book your connection on the web site <http://www.interglobus.pl/rezerwacja-biletu.html>. You can also book a return ticket from the city to the airport. You should type in the windows: From: Goleniów Lotnisko; To: Szczecin PKP

**Price: 16 PLN**

Passengers travelling with LOT can take the LOT bus. This leaves 15 minutes after the plane has landed. Tickets can be purchased from the driver before leaving the bus.

## From Berlin to Szczecin

### By Train

get to Berlin Hbf from Airports use Berlin public transport

(<http://www.bvg.de/index.php/en/index.html>). Trains to Szczecin with a change in Angermünde run almost every hour from Berlin Hauptbahnhof.

You should type in the windows: From: Berlin Hbf; To: Szczecin Główny

**Price: 30–37 €**

**Important information:** You should note that total travel time depends on waiting time at Angermünde.

### By Bus:

You can reserve or order a direct bus at <http://www.interglobus.pl/Default.aspx?language=en>. You should type in the windows:

From: Berlin Tegel or Berlin Schönefeld To:

Szczecin PKP

**Price: 75-150 PLN**

## Travel to the conference venue

### By car

When approaching via route S3 (E65) and S10, merge onto S10 to the city centre and then follow the signs indicating Kołbaskowo and Berlin. After leaving the downtown (pol. Centrum) you should drive on a four-lane road through an open area with some buildings. This area begins at the railway bridge under which you should pass. After a few minutes you will enter a large roundabout next to a complex of several residential blocks. Behind the roundabout you will see a tall, dark-green façade of the building of the Faculty of Management and Economics of Services, which is connected with the building of the Faculty of Humanities. From the roundabout turn right into Krakowska Street, after about 500 m turn back (stay on Krakowska Street). After 300 m, turn into the parking lot.

When approaching by route 31, you will pass by the Szczecin-Podjuchy. Turn left at the traffic lights and go over the Oder River. You will join the so-called Poznań Highway. At the first roundabout after a few kilometers, turn toward the downtown, and at the next roundabout, take the 3rd exit, which is a road at right-angles to the façade of the building of the Faculty of Management and Economics of Services (Krakowska Street) and after about 500 m turn back (stay on Krakowska Street). After 300 m turn into the parking lot.

### By city bus

After leaving the train, go from the platform onto the railway footbridge and take the descent in the direction of the Oder. When leaving the bridge on Kolumba Street, you will find a bus stop for bus lines 61 (Direction to Podjuchy) and 81 (Direction to Przecław). These buses run from 5 AM to 11 PM. The average journey time is approximately 20 minutes, plus 5–10 minutes if traffic is heavy. Tickets can be purchased at the kiosk, which is located next to the bus stop. It is wise to obtain the hour tickets (4 PLN), as the journey may take thirty minutes. The bus stops at nine stops. Get off at the Cukrowa stop.

For the Faculty of Humanities, you can travel only by bus lines number 61 and 81. Bus timetables can be found at <http://www.zditm.szczecin.pl/rozklady/> (only in Polish, but with valid information about changes of schedule).

You can buy bus tickets at kiosks, and before 8 AM and after 6 PM from the bus driver. Note that most of the public transport buses in Szczecin have ticket machines, but it is wise to buy tickets in advance for unforeseen situations.
